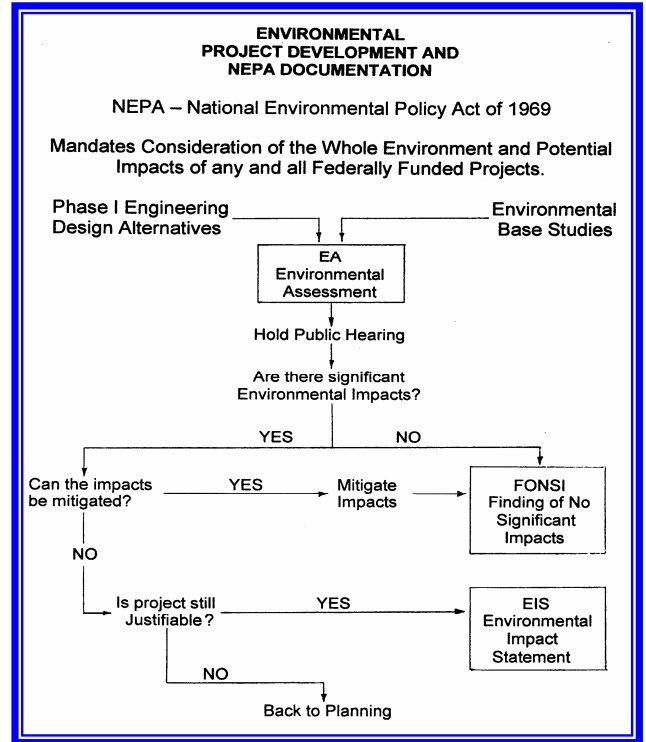

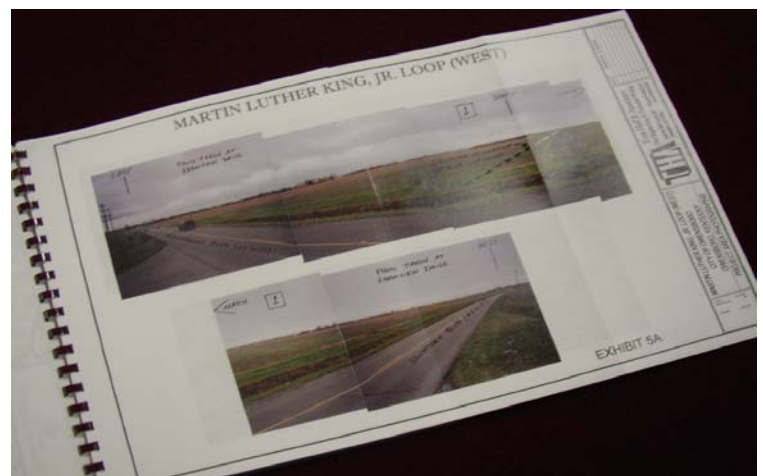
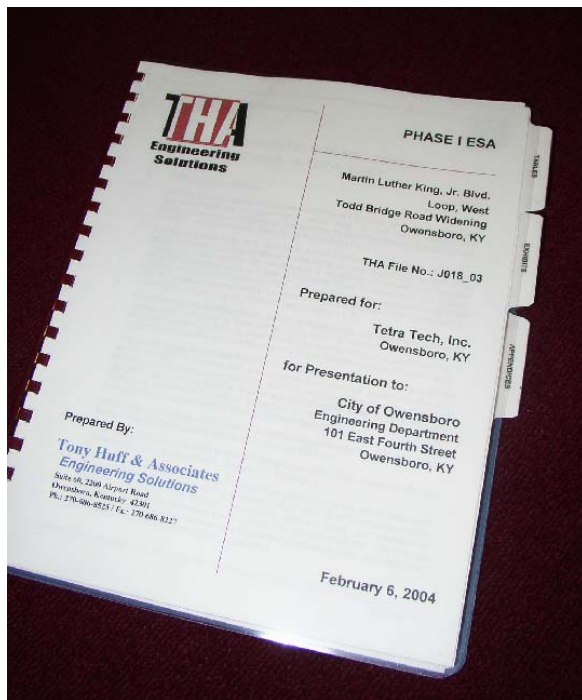

Phase I Environmental Site Assessments
